### DISCUSSION

1. Share something that stood out to you from either the Scriptures or sermon.
2. Which of the character flaws mentioned in these verses is the greatest problem in the church? Please explain your answer.
  - How can you prevent one of these character flaws from overtaking you?
3. Think about this statement: People accept the gospel best when it is offered life-on-life. Do you think this statement is true and what does this mean in your life?
4. Read 1 Thessalonians 2:7 & 11. What does this tell you about the kind of relationships that are needed in order to spread the gospel and grow people in the faith?
5. How can you be a positive influence for someone this week?
