DISCUSSION

- 3. Think about this statement: People accept the gospel best when it is offered life-on-life. Do you think this statement is true and what does this mean in your life?
- 4. Read 1 Thessalonians 2:7 & 11. What does this tell you about the kind of relationships that are needed in order to spread the gospel and grow people in the faith?
- 5. How can you be a positive influence for someone this week?
